# The Equipper

The Equipper -- "Equipping the leaders of RCC through the plain and faithful teaching of God's word."

*"And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him,  
and said to him, "Zacchaeus ..."*

*Luke 19:5*

Does Jesus Notice Me? Zacchaeus, a short-statured man did everything he could to get a glimpse of this popular Messiah. But, did he ever think that Jesus would stop and notice a grown man up in a tree? The natural response would be, no. I don't think Zacchaeus thought so, going by his response in vs. 6. "So he made haste and came down, and received Him joyfully." Zacchaeus was surprised and thrilled at Jesus' plans to go to his house. But, while he was up in that sycamore tree, Zacchaeus most likely, never ever imagined that Jesus would see him there. He was up there to see Jesus, not to be found by Him. I mean, after all, Zacchaeus was a tax collector and a very wealthy one at that. He wasn't winning any popularity contests with his own people--the Jews. He had two strikes against him. 1.He was an employee of Rome and the Jewish people despised being under the rule of the Roman (Gentile) people. 2.Tax collectors had reputations of being greedy and thieves. They typically took more than necessary and pocketed the excess themselves. This pilfering of taxes led to their prosperity and wealth. Zacchaeus was most likely aware of his own vices and how people felt about him. Why would he think Jesus would accept him, let alone want to go to his house? That's what makes Jesus and His grace toward sinners so incredible, so unbelievable. But, that's why Jesus came, not only to notice them, but love them, forgive them and reconcile them. He noticed children in Matt 19, that the disciples didn't want around. He noticed the widow putting 2 coins into the temple receptacle. He noticed the people that were hurting, sick and lame in Matt 9. He had compassion on them because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. One scholar believes that Jesus most likely banished illness from Palestine during the duration of His ministry. We're not sure how many people that is, but to heal all of sickness and disease in a country is very impressive. I think we're a lot like Zacchaeus, or at least I feel

that I am. It's pretty cool to observe Him doing things in other people's lives, but, He wouldn't really want to bother with someone like me, would He? Sometimes were like David in Psalm 8, "What is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him?" Or, like the disciples in the boat when the storm came. "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" (Mark 4:38). We tend to doubt His love, tenderness and caring eye. Peter was one of those disciples in the boat, and look what he wrote about Jesus in his letter. "Casting all your care on Him, for He cares for you." (1 Peter 5:7). I mean, Jesus tells a parable about how God, the Father cares about even one person, when they are missing (Luke 15). He knows about the details of your life and even how many hairs on your head (Psalm 139, Matt 10:30). Back in Genesis 16, we read the story of Hagar and Ishmael. About 10 years has passed since God promised Abraham/Sarah that they would be blessed with a child. There's no child, so Sarah (and Abraham) take matters into their own hands and Sarah arranges for her Egyptian maidservant Hagar and Abraham to have the child. Well, things backfire pretty good on all of them. Hagar gets pregnant. Hagar despises Sarah and Sarah deals harshly with her so, Hagar leaves. An Angel of the Lord (Jesus) meets her and tells her to return to Sarah and be submissive to her and is given a promise to have a large family. After this amazing encounter with the Angel, she called Him THE GOD WHO SEES-- EL ROI (Ro-EE). God saw (and sees) the troubles and trials that we go through. He notices our hurts, pains and loneliness. He sees and feels our frustrations and despair. Like Zacchaeus and Hagar, He will show up anywhere we are in life and bring comfort and healing to our souls. Yes, Jesus notices You! --Pastor Kent
