Father Abram When we first meet Abra (ham), he was Abram. Abram means, "father". The crazy thing about that is, he didn't have any kids, yet. Abram and his wife, Sarai, were barren, a shameful and embarrassing thing in ancient times. We see through the Bible that God always sees what we'll become, not only what we are now. Abram ("father") would eventually become Abraham (Gen 17), meaning, "Father of Many Nations." God was getting ready to change this man's name and his life for time and eternity. God's covenant with Abram first takes place in Gen 12 and is repeated multiple times after that. God didn't want Abram (or us) to ever forget His plan and promises to him. So, let's skip to Gen 22, where God describes to Abraham (now) the extent of just how large this family turned nation will be. "Blessing I will bless you, multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore..." (Gen 22:17). Stars and Sand?! That's quite an amazing promise God makes to Abraham! We know that was a metaphor saying, you're not going to be able to count your descendants! I don't know you if you ever tried to count either one of those, but it would be a futile task. We couldn't do that, but, God can and has. That's the point. God, the Father, was going to bring about this incredible promise to fruition. Why did He choose Abram? Why does He choose any man, for that matter? Go back to before God's calling on his life. Abram was a pagan living in Ur of the Chaldeas. They didn't worship Yahweh God, they worshipped a sun god. So, there was no history of Abram being a faithful, righteous man of God, at all. God sovereignly picks this pagan man and tells him and his family to leave and go to a place that He would show them. How hard would that be to just pick up all your goods and family and leave everyone that was familiar and comfortable behind? We don't see Abram question or complaining. He just simply and humbly does what God asks him to do. How?

The only way that it's possible to follow God --with faith! Faith quietly and patiently moves forward even though things don't make sense. Have you ever been or are you in a situation, a circumstance right now that was/is challenging, difficult, etc? I know you have and so have I. Trouble will find its way into all of our lives at some point. The question is not when will I face trials? It's, how will I respond to them? Will we respond to them by sight--trying to control or solve them? Or, will we respond to them by faith--trusting God for His presence and His purpose to be revealed in all of it? Abram was the right man for the job. Of course, he was, God selected him. Abraham's exceptional reliance on God landed him in the "Hall of Faith" in Hebrews. "By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive an inheritance. And he went out not knowing where he was going." (Heb 11:8). So, what does Abram's story have to do with you? That was 4000 years ago to pagan man and his family living in the Middle East. Really, as a person of faith, it has everything to do with you. It not only marked the beginning of Abram's journey of faith, but yours as well. The reason is because of Jesus, of course. Jesus was a part of Abram's family, his lineage. "The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham." (Matt 1:1). Wow! So, Jesus is related to Abraham? Yes! From his physical bloodline! While, we are not Hebrew, of the Jewish people. Obviously! And, yet we're Abram's child. The relationship to Abram and Jesus are taken to another level--a spiritual one. By faith Abram believed, trusted in God's plan and promises of Jesus, even though he didn't know. We look back on the cross and also, believe God and trust in His plan for Jesus to save the world. Gal 3:29 says it best. "And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise." Abram is our father and our example of faith. If we have faith like he did, then we're in his family and will enjoy all the privileges of the Kingdom! Amen!
