Romans 2:5

What Makes the Good News Really Good

News?! You can't have the Good News of the Gospel (Jesus' death for you on the cross that insures your forgiveness, salvation and your eternal home in heaven) without the bad news of God's judgment on sin. Have you ever been asked, "I have some good news and some bad news. What do you want to hear first?" Regardless of what you want to hear first, no one typically wants to hear bad news. Although, a believer will never be afraid of bad news. Psalm 112:7 says, "He will not be afraid of evil tidings; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the LORD." God's promises are true and relevant for our lives, but we, at times weaken and cave under, right along with unbelievers. The bad news that I'm talking about is the punishment, judgment and wrath of God on hardened and impenitent people. I know that God's wrath is not a popular subject today. In fact, most people would rather ignore and avoid it altogether. One of the loopholes that we try to find with God's wrath is, "Well, A loving God would never send anyone to hell." So, a fallen persons (and even some believers are believing this falsehood) reasoning goes. reason But, no one can humanly themselves out of this truth of Scripture. The wrath of God, is in fact, one of the main themes of the Bible. It's mentioned about 40-50 times, with hundreds of references to it. We need to be careful not to minimize a doctrine, with our opinions that God clearly and repeatedly reveals in the pages of Holy Scripture. His wrath is a necessary and justified component of His judgment on stubborn and rebellious sinners. God wouldn't and couldn't be a holy and righteous God without it. The Bible actually teaches several different kinds of God's wrath: 1.Catastrophic -- As when God judged the sin of the world with the flood in Gen 6-9. 2. Eschatological -- which is God's wrath poured out on sinful and disobedient humanity

at the end of time. We see this wrath in Rev 6-19 with 3 types of judgment--Seal, Trumpets and Bowls. 3. Eternal -- which is God's eternal wrath of hell (eternal, conscience, punishment) on those that rejected Christ. Since the sin of unbelief of Jesus is against an eternal God, the consequences of their sin is eternal as well. 4.Reaping/Sowing -- God displays his judgment on people when they sow to the flesh, they will also reap of the flesh--which is corruption. 5. Turning over. In Romans 1, we read about God displaying His wrath (which is going on now) on rebellious and repentant sin. Whatever sin they are engaged in, God permits them to continue in that sin as a demonstration of His wrath. He turned them over to "uncleanness" (sexual immorality), "vile passions" (homosexual immorality) and to a "debased mind" (a nonfunctioning mind) (Rom 1:24, 26, 28). So, here's the good news! The good news is that believers, Christ-followers will not face the final and eternal wrath of God. And, how is that possible? Through Christ, of course. He took our penalty of sin upon Himself and died in our place, absorbing the wrath of God for our sin (2 Cor 5:21). Our justification is God's deliverance for us from the severe penalty of sin through Jesus. I Thess 1:10 says, "and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come." Yes, God hates sin, is angry with it and will judge it most severely. But, anyone who puts their trust in Christ, will never face His final and eternal wrath. God's wrath truly makes the Good News really Good News! This is a good time to praise God for the Gospel! - Pastor Kent
