_"...I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you... by which you also are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you— unless you believed in vain."

(1Cor 15:1-2)

Vain Belief? Quite possibly, one of the most tragic things in the church, both in the 1st Century and today are people who say they believe in Christ, but really don't. It doesn't seem possible or even right that people in church would profess Christ and then, deny Him by their lifestyle. And, yet the reality shows itself to be true. Most Christians, if they were totally honest, follow Jesus to go to heaven but aren't that interested in following Him everyday. I just came some staggering regarding the church in America today. Every year in America, 4000 churches will close their doors. Just to contrast, 1000 churches will be planted in 2020, but 80% of those new church plants won't make it beyond 3 years. If that doesn't ring loud of the "vain belief" that is plaguing this country, I don't know what would. Wait, there is more! In 1900, there were 27 churches per 10,000 people and in 2020 there are 11 churches per 10,000 people. So that means that in the last 120 years, the number of churches for 10,000 has declined to well below half. 2.7 million church members stopped serving because of busyness and chaos in their lives. Half of the churches in the U.S. did not add any new members in the last 2 years. These stats are sad, revealing an unfortunate truth in the church today. We may not speak what we believe, but our faith is revealed mostly by our actions. James said it best, "faith without works is dead. (James 2:17". We're saved by grace, but we manifest our faith by our Our pulling away from the church, declining attendance in worship and lack of commitment in ministry display what we really think about Christ and His church. When we go back to 1 Cor 15, Paul said that he declared the gospel to them, he preached it to them.

So, they heard it, understood and even responded to it affirmatively. They had received it and stood fast in it and even were saved by it. The Gospel had done it's transforming and regenerating power on some of those in Corinth. There wer Christians in the church in Corinth. But, shockingly, as in all churches, there were also those who "believed in vain". Empty, superficial and hollow professions of faith that didn't intend to make a whole-hearted commitment to Christ. Does it seem possible? If someone doesn't want to believe, follow or obey Christ, why don't they just refuse? Ridicule? Being left out? Scared? They don't want to go to hell? Maybe, they don't understand? Or, maybe fallen people, who love their sin don't really like the Bible and the Gospel and put on a "good face". Eventually, "vain belief" will make itself known. You can't get sweet Paul told water from a bitter spring. Timothy that in the latter day, the Spirit has said that there will be a great falling away from the faith (I Tim :1) and follow after decades of deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons. We have to come down to these two truths 1: Not everyone is a Christian, regardless of what it looks like or how people talk. Jesus told us that the majority of people are on the broad path hat leads to destruction. The narrow way is the way that leads to life and few will find it (Matt 7:13-14). If you haven't come to terms with he Gospel of Christ, you won't be saved (Rom 1:16). 2. Not everyone is going to heaven. Much to the false belief of our culture and to those at every funeral that you will ever attend. We've got to break free from this notion that my good deeds or even good life will get me to heaven. Jesus said, not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord shall enter the Kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of my Father in heaven (Matt7:21). Vain belief turns to real belief in Jesus Christ for salvation and eternal life!


