Courage in a Time of Chaos! My favorite character in the Wizard of Oz is the Cowardly Lion. I feel a lot like him at times. And, you probably do too. Remember, he was asked, What will you ask from the Wizard? COURAGE, was his response. The irony of course is, that he was a lion. Lion's aren't supposed to be afraid. They're the "King of the Jungle." Remember, he was actually afraid of his tail. Christians aren't supposed to be afraid either. Proverbs states, "The wicked flee when no one pursues (a lion's tale), but the righteous are bold as a lion." (Prov 28:1). We don't need to ask the Wizard for courage. We've already been given courage by the Spirit of God. "For God has not given us a spirit of timidity..." (2 Tim 1:7). Then why, since March, have we realized our fears more? Probably because we've focused on them more. Jesus reassured His fearful disciples on the dark and windy Galilee, "Take courage! It is I (literally, I Am) Don't be afraid." (Matt 14:27). Those are some really good words to live by in chaotic times.
