FAREWELL TO YOU... As you're all aware, I resigned as Sr. Pastor from RCC on November 8th. My last Sunday will be Jan 3, 2021. I know some of you were disappointed to hear this news, yet you have remained encouraging and supportive. Some of you have actually told me that you are being selfish, because you don't want us to go. I appreciate your honesty about your struggle. Please know that it wasn't an easy decision to make, either. We (Ana and me) have been praying, thinking and talking about this for several years. Being your pastor for 14 years made the struggle even harder. It's difficult to leave when you've been here that long. But, that's exactly the reason to do so. I have been comfortable in my position and I've also seen how RCC is being stagnant and complacent. Sometimes, in order for change to occur, some drastic changes need to be made. You may be aware of the definition of insanity is--doing the same things over and over again with the same results. I believe I am and RCC is in a rut spiritually and ministerially. I would like to say that much of this is due to Covid-19 and the church being on lockdown from March through June of this year. But, that would not be accurate. Because much of our stagnation has been going on a while. In order for all of us to wake-up, I think we need to go through a shake-up!

The best way to make that happen is to take a step of faith. Faith doesn't mean we have control or understanding. Faith means that I'm going to trust in God to provide and it means the same thing for you as well. David writes, "Whenever I am afraid, I will trust in You." (Ps 56:3) And a few verses later, he says the same thing, only switches the wording around. "In God I have put my trust; I will not be afraid." (Ps 56:11). The whole goal of man in the Bible is to trust God with his whole life no matter what. But, even as Christians, we tend to walk by sight and not faith. I'm feeling a lot like Abraham right now, "And he went out not knowing where he was going." (Heb 11:8). We have no human "safety net"--with no church or no secular job lined up. It will be a great but not an easy lesson for all of us to trust God to provide for a ministry and for the next pastor of RCC. I want to say Thank-you for the last 14 years and are praying for God to display His power and glory through the church here. He has more that He wants to do here to Win, Build Send in the Name of Jesus Christ! Since we're remaining in St. Joe for the time being, I'm not going to say good-bye because our lives may still intersect. But, I will say farewell for now and pray that you all will fight the good fight, keep the faith and finish the race that God has all of you on. Be strong and courageous my brothers and sisters in Christ! --Pastor Kent

It may come as a slight surprise to some of you that I have a fairly large collection of nativity scenes at home. There are many different sizes and themes in my collection. I started collecting them not long after I left my 9 ½ years of working at Walmart. During the time I was employed there, the true meaning of Christmas had been lost for me on the commercialism and hysteria that was involved in consumer marketplace. Christmas to me meant long hours stocking shelves, dealing with grouchy customers, and breaking up fights over Black Friday deals. I dreaded Christmas.

The November following my departure from the insanity at Walmart, the boss at my new job in sales gave me the task of decorating the office building for Christmas. He gave me a budget and some suggestions on decorations, but one thing he said to me really stood out. He said, "Be sure to get a nativity scene and make it prominent.
