Rising Above with Thanksgiving In his 2nd letter to the Corinthians, the apostle Paul is defending himself against the attacks of some false teachers. He's also facing some other trials that caused him to lose some sleep. And, right in the middle of his woes, he breaks out into thankfulness. “Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.” (2 Cor 2:14). Paul rises (and we can too) above his difficulties by focusing on thanksgiving. Thanksgiving helps us to be appreciative of what we have in Christ and not get bogged down with our problems. In this verse, Paul thanks God for 3 things. 1. God always leads us. He's our sovereign God, who will always lead us in and through whatever struggles we have. He's got everything under complete control. 2. We have victory in Christ. God will lead us in triumph in Christ. Our victory is not from us, but from Jesus. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor 15:57). 3. God uses us to

influence and change the world. He supplies this “fragrance” that gives off a sweet smelling scent to the world—that witnesses to the world of the love, joy and hope of Jesus Christ. Don't let your difficulties keep you from breaking out into an anthem of praise and Thanksgiving!
