Love Your Neighbor

Growing up in Rosendale is a fond memory for me. It was a lot like Mayberry in my mind. One of the things I looked forward to as a little child in town was when it was Ms. Iris Miller's day to walk to Beattie's store to pick up some groceries. Her path to and from her home to the store uptown (uptown and downtown Rosendale were two blocks apart) led her directly down the sidewalk in front of my house. I would watch her go by and wave as she went to the store, then wait on my front porch step for her to return. Mom had taught me previously that it would be a nice gesture to help Ms. Miller with her groceries on her return trip. She said, "That's being a good neighbor." So, whether Ms. Miller had enough for two bags of groceries or not, she always had it bagged up in two bags so I would get to carry one for her. I realize as an adult now that the trek to her house was all of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a block, but as a 6-year-old boy, I thought she lived halfway across Missouri. Our journey together consisted of small talk and well wishes. My reward for the journey was to get to see her mynah bird that knew how to say a few words. After a few minutes, Ms. Miller would thank me for my help and I would begin my walk (or run, or skip) back down the hill to my home proud that I had done a good deed and thrilled that she got the bird to tell the dogs to "Get Outta Here!!!"

I miss those days. I miss Ms. Miller and all the other neighbors of my childhood. I've come to realize that as much as I thought I was serving and caring for Ms. Iris Miller, the reality was, she was serving and loving her little neighbor - me. She taught me to walk and talk with people ... genuinely caring about their life and their needs. She taught me to share some of the unique things that I have acquired, even if it might be a weird, temperamental bird. Most importantly, she taught me that letting other people care for and serve us - even when we don't necessarily need it - is mutually beneficial.

I'm reminded of Jesus' words in Mark 12:30-31

30 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' 31 The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."

I think some of the conversations that Ms. Miller and I had may have touched on God sometimes. I really don't remember. What I do know is that in her actions, she showed me what it was to be the kind of neighbor Jesus is teaching in these verses.

I want to make my goal each day to do better at Loving God and Loving Others ... care to join me in that journey? Rich <><
